On Monday 28th February, the West Australian Government announced that Phase 2 restrictions will be implemented state-wide on Thursday 3rd March

The Kalgoorlie-Boulder Community Fair Society Inc has been in regular contact with relevant officers from the WA Health Department about measures to take during the Fair to ensure good hygiene by vendors in light of the COVID-19 Corona Virus. While we are totally devastated by this decision, we must abide by the mandates to help keep

I would like to assure the Community that we are taking the best advice and based on the most recent announcement by the State Premier that the recommendation is not to hold mass gatherings involving more than 500 people, it is now unlikely that the 2022 Community Fair will go ahead.
