Schedule & Guidelines



ENTRY CONDITIONS

1. Entry Forms will be accepted from one month prior to the Fair (Mail, in person or by email).
2. The closing date for entry forms will be Wednesday 25 March 2020.
3. This will enable to Organisers to establish the amount of space that will be required to display the entries.
4. **Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the organiser.**
5. The Fair Society Executive committee can alter the Guidelines at any time for the betterment of all involved in any of the classes in the competition.
6. Entry forms and entry fee can be dropped off to Fair office at the Cruickshank Sports Arena on the following days:
 - a. Monday 23 March to Thursday 26 March between 10am and 4pm. If you need to make alternate arrangements, please call the Fair Office on 08 9021 4995.
 - b. Entries will not be accepted after 5pm Thursday 26 March 2020.
7. All classes are open to all community members, community groups and schools, with the exception of judges and their immediate families.
8. Prizes will be awarded at 6pm Saturday 28 March 2020 in the Wool Pavilion.
9. At the end of the presentation those with entries can collect their items.
10. Please bring containers/boxes for collecting your items.
11. If unable to collect on Saturday 28 March, then alternate arrangements can be made with the Co Ordinator.
12. Exhibits will be benched by 4pm on the evening of Thursday 26 March 2019.
13. Judging will take place 6pm Thursday 26 March.
14. All care will be taken, but NO responsibility will be accepted by the Kalgoorlie-Boulder Community Fair Society if any item goes missing.
15. All exhibitors grant permission to the organisers to publish and/or broadcast the names and photographs of the finalists and the winners through print and electronic media.

16. The judges' decision is final in every situation including any not covered above and no correspondence will be entered into.
17. Entrants will be deemed to have accepted these rules and to agree to be bound by them when registering for this competition.
18. All herbs, fruit and vegetables must be grown by the exhibitor.
19. Fruit must have stalk and foliage attached.
20. All herbs, fruit and vegetables must be clean and free from disease or insects to avoid disqualification.
21. Please label all varieties known.
22. The Society reserves the right to declare no competition in any class that it deems appropriate.
23. Should the Judges consider the exhibits do not meet standard, the Association may withhold any or all of the prizes.

ENTRY GUIDELINES

- All herbs, fruit and vegetables must be grown by the exhibitor.
- All root vegetables must be complete with tops trimmed to 7cms and dirt removed.
- All exhibits in fruit Classes must have stalk and foliage attached.
- All herbs, fruit and vegetables must be clean and free from disease or insects to avoid disqualification.
- No wrapping of Vegetables or fruit.
- Please label all varieties known.

PRIZES

- Each Section will have Prizes allocated dependent on entries received.
- The Judges' decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- Prizes will be awarded at the Judges' discretion. Even though there may be entries in Sections, prizes may not be awarded.
- Prize money/ ribbons will be awarded for 1st and 2nd places in all sections.
- The winning entry in each category will receive a Championship ribbon and prize money.

- Class 7: Herbs, collection of at least 3 and no more than 5
- Class 8: Lettuce, any variety, 1
- Class 9: Onions, any variety, 3
- Class 10: Peas, any variety, 5
- Class 11: Pumpkin, any variety, 1
- Class 12: Tomatoes, any variety of large tomato, 3
- Class 13: Tomatoes, any variety cherry tomato, 5
- Class 14: Zucchini, 2
- Class 15: Any other vegetable, 1

- Class 16: Citrus fruit, any other variety, 3
- Class 17: Lemons, 3
- Class 18: Watermelon whole, largest
